

Libreville Airport Carbon Commitment



Climate change has made governments and organizations aware of the importance of reducing the overall environmental impact of human activities and combating climate change.

The transportation sector and particularly the aviation sector, through its airports, cannot remain on the sidelines of these global challenges and is increasingly taking measures to act effectively in support of climate action and environmental protection.

It is against this backdrop that Libreville Airport, in collaboration with its airport partners, has decided to adopt a voluntary initiative to track, monitor, and reduce its greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.

As a result, Libreville Airport has decided to commit to Level 4+ under the Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA) program. This program, developed by the International Airports Council, is designed to help us effectively reduce our carbon footprint and improve efficiency by cutting our energy consumption.



As part of this initiative and our Level 4+ accreditation, we have set the following objectives :

- Outline guidelines to better track our environmental impacts and plan our reduction strategy ;
- Establish a reduction pathway for our controlled sources (Scopes 1 & 2) of at least 90%, with offsetting of residual emissions ;
- Quantify the airport's indirect emissions to influence Scope 3 emissions, including those of our partners ;
- Continue sharing best practices by engaging with key stakeholders through the environmental committee.

I urge every stakeholder to work toward the well-being of the planet, keeping future generations in mind.
